

Recommend a Youth & Children's Minister Candidate

Holy Cross has a deep-rooted commitment to youth ministries, offering numerous opportunities for young people to serve and grow in their Christian faith. As Proverbs 22:6 teaches, "Train up a child in the way he should go; and when he is old, he will not depart from it." In line with this, Holy Cross seeks a passionate youth minister, male or female, dedicated to nurturing young people's faith and service to the Lord.

Holy Cross will continue to review Commissioned Minister Information Forms from the Texas District, while also exploring other potential avenues, including:

1. LCMS youth ministers serving other churches, recommended by church members.
2. LCMS members who are educators or pursuing education degrees and interested in youth work.
3. Members of Holy Cross who are interested and capable of serving as a youth minister.
4. Other faithful Christians interested in youth ministry and Christian education.

Candidates not educated within our Synod must meet the following requirements to be considered:

1. Subscribe to all doctrines of the LCMS.
2. Undergo mentorship and training with Pastor Mike Hafer or other qualified individuals or institutions.

Holy Cross members who wish to recommend a candidate are encouraged to contact the church office. Holy Cross will accept candidate recommendations through the end of October, conduct interviews in November, and recommend a candidate to the Voters. If no suitable candidate is found within this timeline, Holy Cross may consider utilizing a talent sourcing agency.
